The friars of St. Bonaventure Province gathered on May 15, 2012 for an Extraordinary Chapterto prayand vote on propsals concerning our brothers in Australia. The Very Reverend Jude Winkler, Vicar General attended on behalf of the Very Reverend Marco Tosca, Minister General of the Order.

Two votes were taken:

- 1) To welcome the friars and friaries of Our Lady Help of Christians into the Province of St. Bonaventure. Of the 35 legitimate voting members present (being a quorum of the 40 eligible voters), 34 voted in the affirmative, 1 voted negative. The motion passed.
- 2) To establish the Provincial "Delegation" of Australia as a Provincial "Custody" by January 13, 2014. Of the 35 legitimate voting members present (being a quorum of the 40 eligible voters), 34 voted in the affirmative. 1 voted negative. The motion passed.

Pending the rescript from the Holy See, (by June 1, 2012) the General Definitory will vote to confirm the vote of St. Bonaventure Province and





will suppress Australia as General Custody. On June 12, 2012 the Definitory of St. Bonaventure Province will meet to create Australia as a Provincial Delegation, and will appoint a Provincial Delegate.


